Still lifes, wine, markets and terraces for the dining room and the bar. Painted by hand in oil on canvas, in any size, at 20% to 30% off retail by volume.

Delivered in about 4 weeks: about 3 weeks to paint, then 3 to 10 days to ship.

Volume pricing: 20% off retail at 1 to 4 pieces, 25% at 5 to 9, 30% at 10 or more, on the canvas and on the framing. Made to order in about 3 weeks, plus 3 to 10 days in transit. 50% deposit by bank transfer starts production, balance due on photo approval.

Louie Drehmer grew up surrounded by art. His mother is an expert painter, and he spent his childhood watching her work, learning to see the world through brushstrokes and color. Years later, during an art residency in a remote village of painters, everything clicked: local masters who had each spent a lifetime perfecting one style. One had dedicated forty years to Impressionist landscapes. Another knew Baroque shadow and light like nobody else.

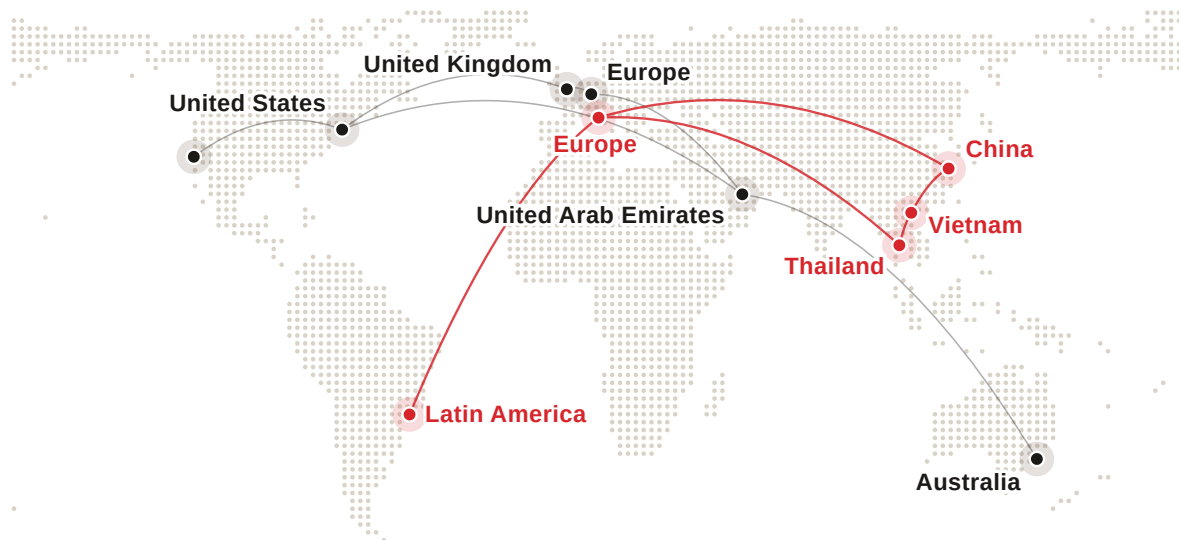
Most reproduction companies treat art like a production line: an order comes in, it goes to whoever is available. A Van Gogh lands with a portrait specialist; the painting comes out fine technically, but the feeling is gone.

"You can't ask a portrait specialist to capture Impressionist light. You can't expect someone trained in photorealism to understand Abstract Expressionist gesture. Each style has its own language."

So Art & See does it differently. Every commission is matched to an artist who specializes in that exact style. A Monet only goes to an Impressionist, a Caravaggio only to someone who lives and breathes Baroque. No exceptions.

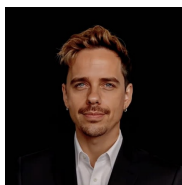

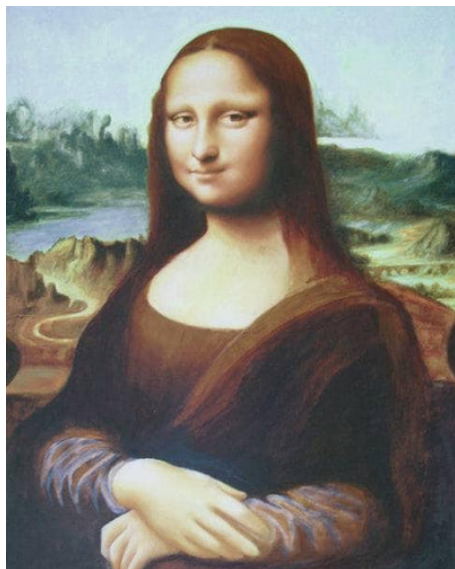

Canvases ship rolled and insured, or stretched and framed, ready to hang. Finishing is priced by size on the wholesale pricing page.

05

Any public-domain work

Not in this catalog? We paint any work in the public domain on request, at the same wholesale pricing.

06

Volume pricing

20% off retail at 1 to 4 pieces, 25% at 5 to 9, and 30% at 10 or more, on the canvas and on the framing.

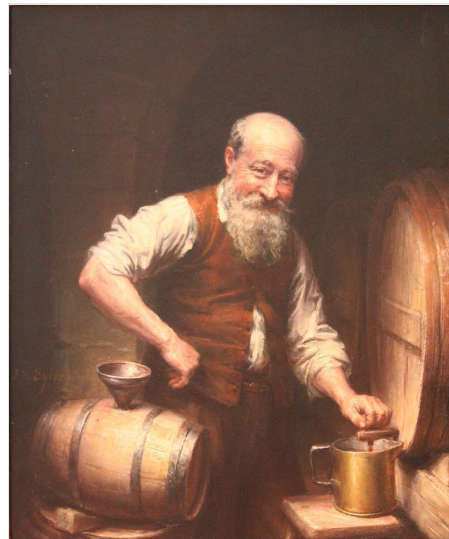

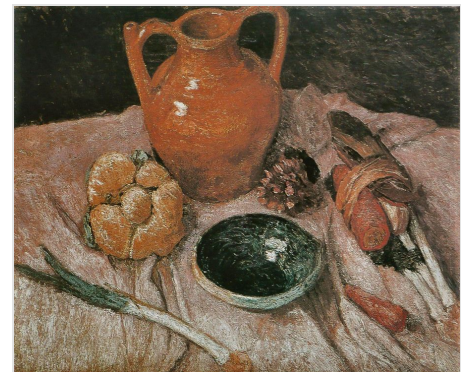

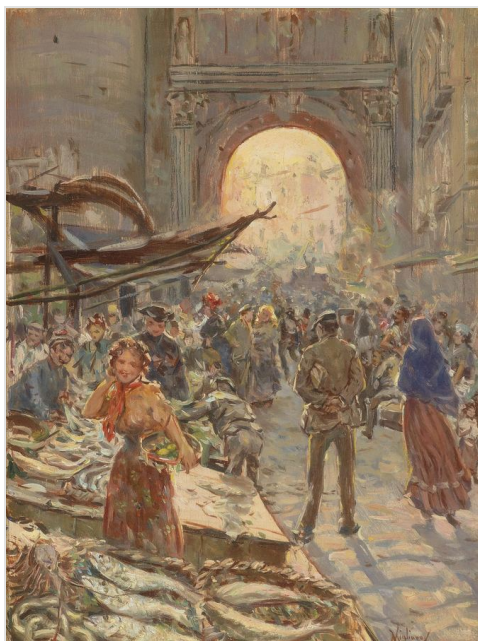

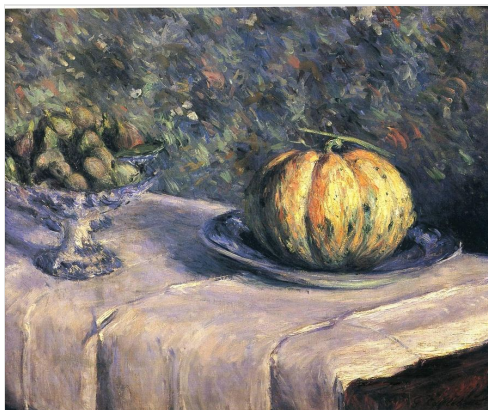

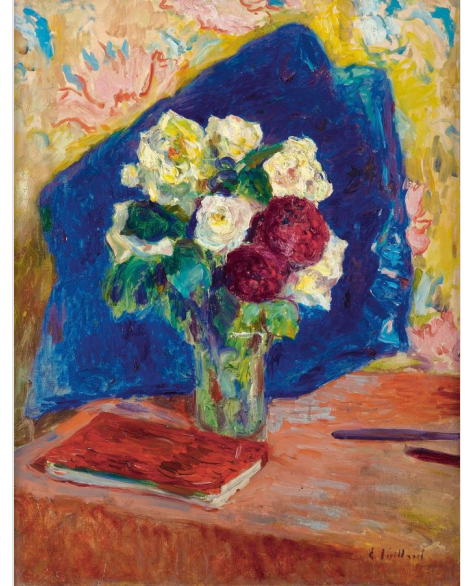

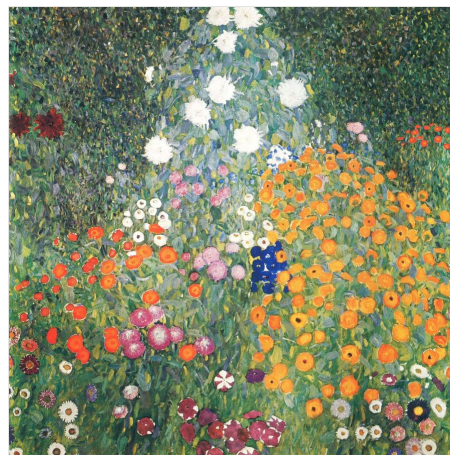

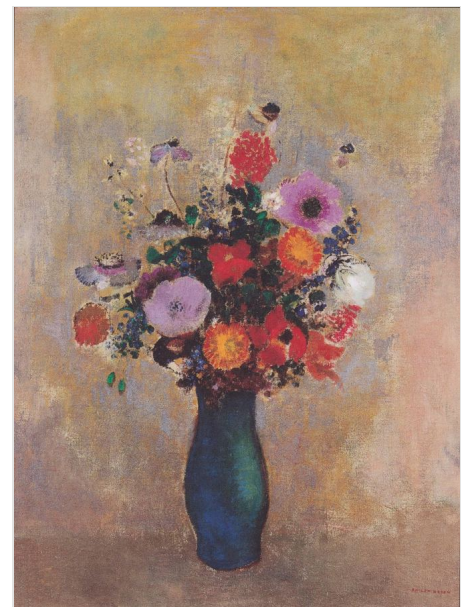

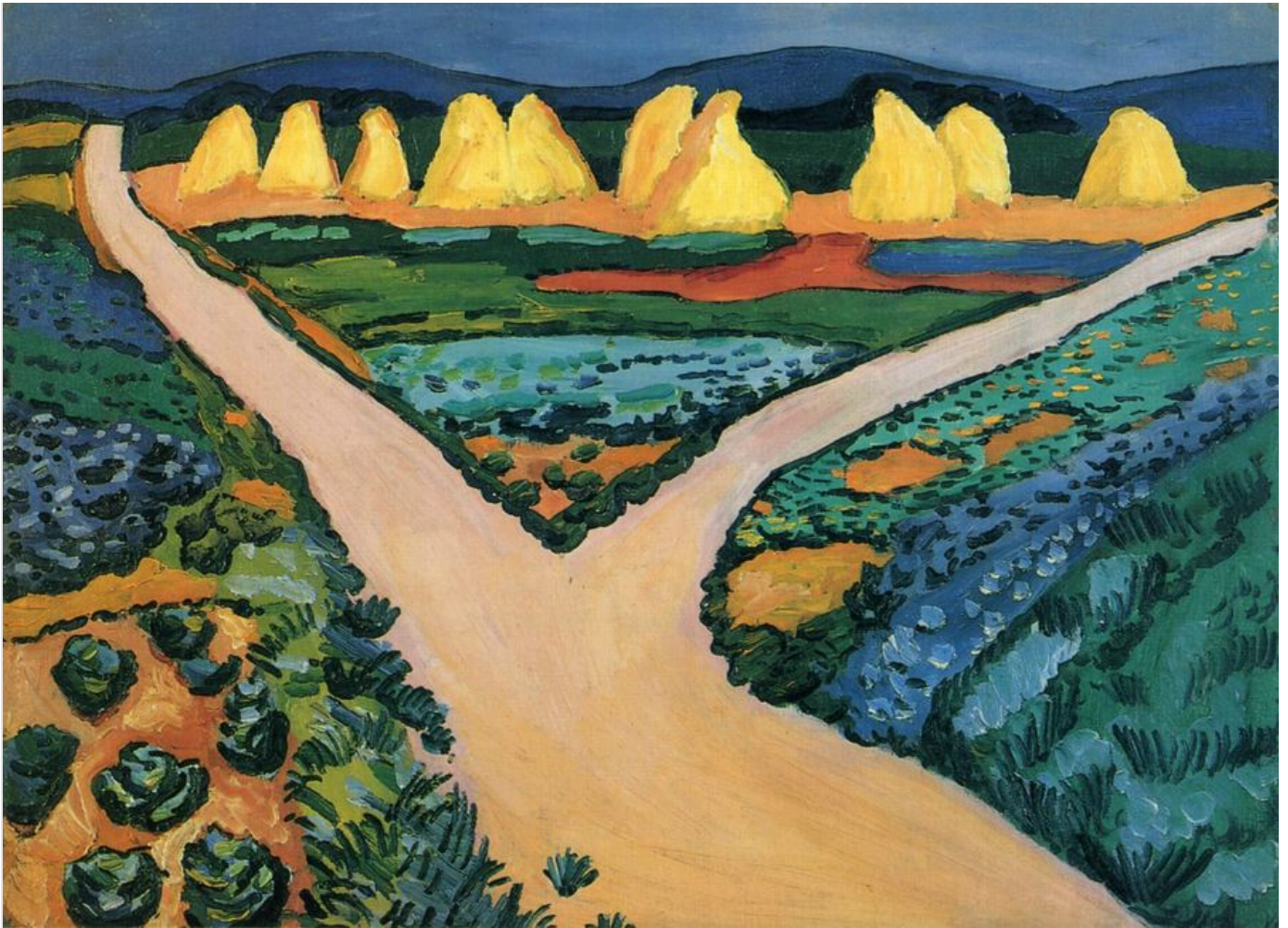

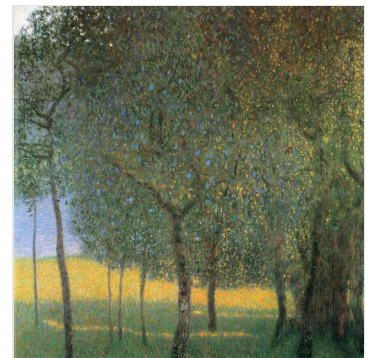

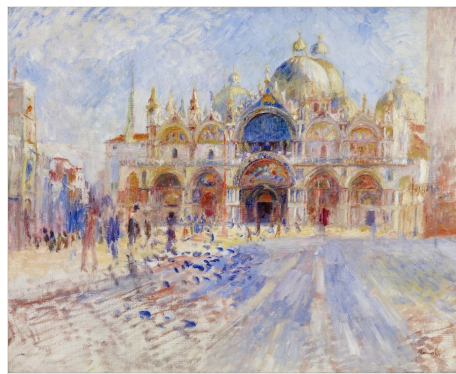

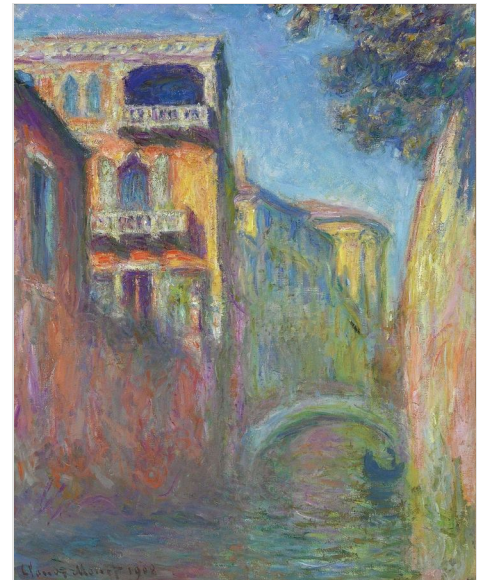

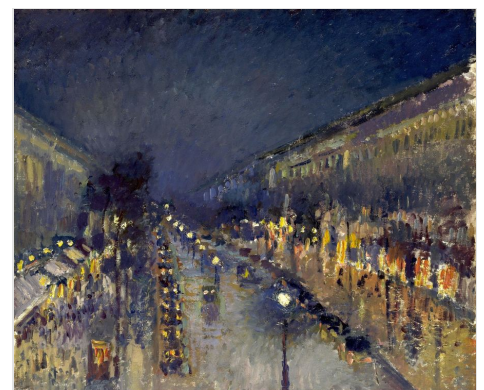

Email the works, the sizes and a frame, if you want one. A title or a photo is enough. We reply with one consolidated quote within 24 hours.

03

Approve the photographs

When the paintings are finished we send high resolution photographs for sign off. Adjustments are free. The balance is due on approval.

02

A deposit starts production

A 50% deposit by bank transfer starts production: ACH or Fedwire in the US, SWIFT elsewhere. Net 30 after two completed orders.

04

Delivery

About 4 weeks from deposit to your door. Canvases ship rolled and insured, worldwide, in 3 to 10 days after approval. Stretching, framing and freight for oversized pieces are quoted with the order.
